



MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGES AT GARTREE HIGH SCHOOL

The Modern Languages Department is made up of a committed team of teachers who cooperate enthusiastically in the development of new teaching and learning initiatives and materials. There are three full time and two-part time members of staff.

French is taught throughout years 7 to 10 with two fifty minute lessons in Year 7, and three fifty minute lessons in Years 8, 9 and 10.

Pupils have a taster course in Spanish in Year 8 and can choose to opt for Spanish, instead of French, starting in Year 9.

At KS4 both French and Spanish are taught using the AQA syllabus.

The department supports inclusivity and all groups of pupils make excellent progress. Our results are consistently well above the national average at KS3.

Each year a trip to Normandy visits a French Chateau for a week of outdoor pursuits and French speaking.
