



The Humanities Department

The Humanities Department is responsible for the delivery of all KS3 Humanities and KS4 Geography, History, Business Studies/Economics, Sociology and RE. Humanities is taught in mixed ability form groups by a team of committed specialist teachers.

History, Geography and Religious Studies are taught as discrete subjects in 50 minute lessons. Students receive two lessons of History and two lessons of Geography per week and Religious Studies is taught to all year groups via a single lesson. A modular approach is adopted by the department.

We have a suite of six rooms. All of which benefit from a promethean board. We are a resource rich department with a range of text books and electronic interactive resources. All schemes of learning and assessment are in place. Teaching in the department is of a very high standard leading to outstanding outcomes at the end of KS3. There are a number of field trips, both local and international, that take place throughout the year.
